

Introduction to HelloMedic NEET 2025

The National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) is a national-level medical entrance examination conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) for admission into MBBS, BDS, and other undergraduate medical programs in government, private, and deemed institutions across India. NEET UG serves as the sole entrance test for medical admissions in India, offering approximately 1.7 lakh MBBS and BDS seats nationwide.

As per the Supreme Court directive of 2016, NEET UG has replaced the All India Pre-Medical Test (AIPMT) and all state-level medical entrance exams. It is now the only valid examination for securing admission into all government, private, and deemed medical and dental colleges. NEET UG is conducted in offline (pen and paper) mode by NTA.

For NEET 2025, candidates must stay updated on the official exam schedule, which includes the release of admit cards, answer keys, and results. Since 2020, admissions to MBBS seats in all 15 AIIMS institutes and 2 JIPMER institutes are also based on NEET scores, accounting for 1,205 AIIMS seats and 200 JIPMER seats.

NEET UG 2025 Score Acceptance

NEET UG scores are valid for admission into:

- 15% All India Quota seats in government medical and dental colleges across India.
- 85% State Quota seats in government and private medical/dental colleges of respective states and Union Territories.
- MBBS/BDS seats in private and deemed universities, including minority institutions like CMC Vellore and CMC Ludhiana.
- Seats in prestigious institutions such as Armed Forces Medical College (AFMC), Banaras Hindu University (BHU), and Aligarh Muslim University (AMU).
- Admission to AIIMS and JIPMER MBBS programs, which are now integrated under NEET UG.

- 15% All India Quota seats: Admission is managed by the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) under the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) via online counselling.



NEET (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test) is the single national-level entrance exam for admission to nearly 1.17 lakh undergraduate (UG) and postgraduate (PG) medical and dental seats across India. The exam is categorized into NEET UG for MBBS and BDS admissions and NEET PG for postgraduate medical courses.

NEET UG is applicable to all medical and dental colleges established by:

- Central and state governments
- Universities and deemed universities
- Private trusts, societies, and corporations
- Minority institutions
- Institutes of National Importance (INIs) such as AIIMS and JIPMER




Common Counselling Process

Key features of the common counselling system:

- Transparent Fee Structure: All medical and dental institutions must declare their fees before counselling, allowing students to make informed financial decisions.
- Single-window Admission: Deemed universities, minority institutions, and private medical colleges must participate in centralized counselling, conducted by the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) on behalf of the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC).
- Reduced Seat Vacancies: Candidates securing a seat in Round 2 of the AIQ counselling will no longer be eligible for state-level counselling. This prevents last-minute dropouts and ensures better seat utilization.

With these structured reforms, NEET UG 2025 continues to provide a fair, transparent, and streamlined admission process, ensuring that every deserving aspirant gets the best opportunity to pursue medical education in India.

NEET UG 2025: Eligibility Criteria

Candidates aspiring to appear for NEET UG 2025 must meet the eligibility criteria set by the National Testing Agency (NTA). Failure to fulfil these criteria will result in disqualification from admission.

Age Criteria:

- The candidate must be at least 17 years old on or before December 31, 2025 to be eligible for MBBS/BDS admission.
- There is no upper age limit for NEET UG, as per the Supreme Court ruling (2017).

Nationality:

Eligible candidates include:

- Indian Nationals
- Non-Resident Indians (NRIs)
- Overseas Citizens of India (OCIs)
- Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs)
- Foreign Nationals

Educational Qualification:

Candidates must have passed the following subjects individually in their qualifying examination:

- Physics
- Chemistry
- Biology/Biotechnology
- English

Minimum qualifying marks (PCB aggregate):

Category Minimum Marks Required

- General (UR) 50%
- SC/ST/OBC 40%
- General-PH 45%
- SC-PH/ST-PH/OBC-PH 40%

Candidates appearing for Class 12 board exams in 2025 can apply for NEET UG provisionally, but must fulfil the eligibility criteria upon result declaration.

State Quota & AIQ:

Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh do not participate in the 15% All India Quota (AIQ) scheme. Candidates from these UT's are not eligible for AIQ seats unless they apply under AIQ eligibility conditions separately.

NEET UG 2025: Exam Pattern

NEET UG 2025 will be conducted in a pen-and-paper (offline) format. The exam consists of 180 multiple-choice questions (MCQs) covering Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (Botany & Zoology) as per the prescribed NEET UG syllabus.

Language Options:

NEET UG will be conducted in eight regional languages along with Hindi and English.

Important Note:

- The language medium must be selected while filling out the application form and cannot be changed later.
- Regional language options are restricted to states where they are officially recognised, except English and Urdu, which can be chosen at any exam center.
- Candidates who choose English will receive the question paper only in English.
- Candidates who choose Hindi or other regional languages will receive a bilingual question paper (selected language + English).

Step 5: Acknowledgement Receipt & Document Retention

Candidates who need to correct errors in their uploaded images or application details can follow the steps below to make the necessary changes.

Correction of Uploaded Images

Candidates with discrepancies in their photograph or signature must correct them by following these steps:

- 1. Visit the NEET UG 2025 candidate login portal.
- 2. Enter your application number and password (received at the time of registration).
- 3. The option to upload the correct photograph/signature will be displayed.
- 4. Re-upload the correct image as per the specified guidelines.
- 5. Verify the uploaded image before submitting.
- 6. Upon submission, an OTP will be sent to the registered mobile number and email ID.
- 7. Enter the OTP, and the NEET correction slip will be displayed.
- 8. Download and print the correction slip for future reference.

Correction of Personal & Application Details

Candidates who need to modify personal details, address, category, or other information can follow these steps:

- 1. Login to the NEET candidate portal using your registration number and password.
- 2. Click on the button "Click Here for Corrections in NEET Application."
- 3. Modify the incorrect details and click on 'Preview and Submit.'

NEET UG 2025 Dress Code

Allowed Attire:

Clothing:

- Light-colored clothes with half sleeves.
- Simple attire without big buttons or embroidery.

- Boys: Slippers only (no shoes).

Not Allowed:

- Full-sleeve clothes, jeans, leggings, or heavy embroidery.
- Shoes or closed footwear.
- · Watches, wristbands, cameras, or any ornaments.

For Candidates Wearing Customary Dress:

NEET UG 2025 Answer Key

The NEET UG 2025 result is expected to be declared in the last week of September 2025. NEET UG CUT OFF

The NEET UG cutoff is the minimum score a candidate must achieve to qualify for the exam and proceed with the admission process. It is categorised into two types:

- 1. Qualifying Cutoff The minimum marks required to pass the NEET UG exam.
- 2. Admission Cutoff The score necessary for securing a seat in medical and dental colleges across the country.

The NEET UG cutoff is determined by various factors, including the number of available seats, the total number of applicants, the exam's difficulty level, and the marking scheme. Based on this cutoff, the National Testing Agency (NTA) classifies candidates as qualified or non-qualified for the exam.

Additionally, the top 15% of qualified candidates become eligible to participate in the 15% All India Quota (AIQ) counselling. The rank range for this quota is declared separately.

The admission cutoff for NEET UG varies by state, institution, and category. To qualify, candidates must achieve a minimum percentile score:

- General (UR) category candidates must secure at least the 50th percentile.
- SC/ST/OBC category candidates must score at least the 40th percentile.

These cutoffs ensure that only the most eligible candidates proceed to the next stage of medical and dental admissions.

NEET UG 2024 Qualifying Cutoff Scores

The National Testing Agency (NTA) released the NEET UG 2024 qualifying cutoff scores, which were higher compared to previous years due to an increased number of high-scoring candidates. The category-wise qualifying percentiles and corresponding score ranges are as follows:

General (UR)	50th	720-162
SC/ST/OBC	40th	161-127
General-PwD	45th	161-144

NEET UG Counselling

The NEET UG counselling is expected to begin in the first week of October, approximately one week after the declaration of results. The Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), on behalf of the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), is responsible for conducting counselling for:

- 15% All India Quota (AIQ) seats
- · Seats in central and deemed universities

- Jammu and Kashmir does not participate in the All India Quota (AIQ). Instead, it conducts separate counselling for 100% of its state quota seats.
- Counselling is conducted online and consists of two rounds for admissions to government medical and dental colleges across India.

Reporting at Allocated Colleges After Second Round of Counselling

Candidates allotted a seat in the second round of NEET UG counselling must report to their respective colleges with the required original documents for verification. Failure to present the necessary documents will result in the cancellation of the allotted seat, making the candidate ineligible for MBBS or BDS admission through NEET UG.

- Category Certificate (SC/ST/OBC), if applicable Issued by a competent authority
- PwD Certificate, if applicable Issued as per guidelines in the NEET UG prospectus

NEET UG Counselling Process

- Candidates declared eligible by NTA must register online for counselling through the official website.
- Click on the "New Registration"tab and enter details such as:
 - NEET Roll Number
 - All India Rank (AIR)
 - Percentile Score
- Upon successful registration, candidates will be allotted a unique username and password for further login.

2. Choice Filling & Locking Preferences

- Candidates must select their preferred medical and dental colleges from the available list
- Choices can be modified, interchanged, or rearranged multiple times before the final submission.
